## U4 Program - Spring Season 2010

“Freedom Tykes” is for our newest generation of players not quite ready for a regular season. This is for kids who are simply interested in having FUN while learning the very basics of soccer (how to kick a ball, stop a ball, score a goal, etc.).

Players need an adult willing and able to interact with the child. There are not specific coaches at this age. The Director of Recreation (with some assistance) will spend the first 30 minutes teaching the players basic soccer skills. They will spend the last 30 minutes organizing small sided soccer games to allow the players to apply the skills that they are learning. Players will be grouped differently each week.
